All pets are required to be up to date on DHPP/DHLPP, CIV, Bordetella, Rabies and fecal test. Must be spayed/neutered if over 6 months

Camp Schedule

6 am to 9 am	Full & half day dogs are dropped off
9 am to 12 pm	Morning group play
12 pm to 2 pm	Lunch and rest time—the room is darkened and music is played
12 pm to 2 pm	Morning half day dogs are picked up, afternoon half days dropped off
2 pm to 5 pm	Afternoon group play
5 pm to 6 pm	Rest before pick up time

PLEASE CALL If you will be late we will stay up to 6:30. After that your pet will stay overnight at your expense.

How is FHAC different?

- We limit our groups to 10 dogs per camp counselor
- Our groups are always supervised
- Groups are put together depending on size, age, and personality
- In addition to socializations and off leash play in a safe clean environment, all dogs will receive some instruction on indoor manners

How do I apply for camp?

- Fill out an application which can be mailed to you, picked up at our front desk, or completed and printed from our website: www.foresthomeanimalclinic.com
- After we receive the application, an appointment for an evaluation will be set up
- If your dog successfully passes our temperament evaluation, they can join one of our groups





Dog Boarding

The Cabin—Do you want the best for you companion? Of course! Any caring pet owner would. So why not stay in our finest and most luxurious accommodations available for your pet? Have your companion stay in any one of three special Cabins complete with a TV and DVD player to stimulate your pets mind as well as keep them care-free for hours. Every dog staying in a cabin receives a daily playtime with a caring counselor to keep them healthy. For older dogs who may not enjoy running around in our enclosed area outside, petting and brushing is always an option too.



Your pet will receive the best of care when staying in our Deluxe Cabins, including their very own bed. If you feel like your pet may be more comfortable sleeping in their own bed, feel free to bring it along with a few toys as well. We want your pet to feel safe and secure during their stay

with us. Each guest receives a special snack each day.

The Lodge—Sturdy and secure, the Lodge is roomy and comfortable with solid walls for safety and privacy. Each Lodge has a raised resting platform and a drain below each to keep your pet dry in case of an over-turned water dish. Dishes are provided so your pet's bowls will not be lost or forgotten. Blankets can be supplied, or you can choose to bring your pet's as well as a few toys to keep them content. Rawhides and nylabones are welcome, but will be removed at the end of the day for safety reasons.



The Bed & Breakfast—For dogs under 20 pounds, the Bed and Breakfast is a cozy and comfortable space for your small companion. Safe and secure, the Bed and Breakfast's solid walls allow for privacy, yet is still open enough to be roomy. Bring your own bed or we can supply one for your pet. We always want to make sure your companion stays stress free, treats or toys may help make the transition easier on your pet. If you would like to maintain your dog's normal diet, please bring along their food in individually bagged meals or container.




Cat Boarding

A secluded room for our feline friends offer peace and quiet from the normally noisy kennels. Supervised time outside of their condo is available to play with some toys, climb the scratching post, or just to sit and enjoy nature.



Please feel free to bring your cat's normal food, a blanket and toys for them to enjoy during their stay. Familiar scents will help keep your pet at ease and stress free. Litter boxes and dishes for food and water are provided so that your pet's will not be left behind or forgotten.

All cats must be up to date with PRC (distemper complex), Rabies and an annual fecal test.
