Contract

This is a Contract between Matthew J. Ehrenberg and Janet L. Berens, dba California Cat Center (hereinafter called "California Cat Center") and the pet owner whose signature appears below (hereinafter called "Owner").

1. Owner agrees to pay the rate for grooming in effect on the date pet is checked into the California Cat Center.
2. Owner further agrees to pay all costs and charges for special services requested, and all veterinary costs for the pet during the time said pet is in the care of California Cat Center. Owner further agrees to be financially responsible for any required treatment for fleas/ticks or other pests, if determined necessary by California Cat Center.
3. Owner further agrees that the pet shall not leave California Cat Center, until all charges are paid. Owner hereby releases California Cat Center from responsibility for any and all personal items brought with the pet, including but not limited to toys, blankets, towels and pet furniture. Owner also releases use of pet's image in any publicity.
4. By signing this contract and leaving his/her pet with California Cat Center, Owner certifies the accuracy of all information given about said pet.
5. If the pet becomes ill or if the state of the pet's health otherwise requires professional attention, the California Cat Center, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the pet, and the expense thereof shall be paid by Owner.
6. This Contract contains the entire agreement between the parties. All terms and conditions of the Contract shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of California Cat Center.
7. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Contract, or the breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to this Contract, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgement upon the award rendered by an arbitrator may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitrator shall, as part of this award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the cost of such arbitration and reasonable attorney's fees of the prevailing party.
