Laboratory testing before anesthesia increases the safety level for your pet just as it does for people. Pre-surgical blood testing is economical and can now be done quickly in house with minimum of discomfort to your pet.

*If your pet is under 7 years of age we recommend:*

- Vetscan Prep Profile (consists of 5 tests including liver test, kidney tests, blood sugar, and blood protein.)  
  CBC/Differential (checks for anemia, dehydration, infection, and blood clotting.)

*If your pet is 7 years old or older, we recommend:*

- Vetscan Profile Plus (consists of 12 tests including liver test, kidney tests, blood sugar, blood proteins, cholesterol, potassium, calcium and pancreatic test.)  
  CBC/Differential (checks for anemia, dehydration, infection, and blood clotting.)  
  EKG (helps evaluate the heart size, rhythm, and conduction.)

Risks with anesthetic procedures can include death and results cannot be guaranteed. I also understand that no staff member will be on duty after hours and I may take my pet home or to the Nashville Pet Emergency Clinic, if overnight observation is needed or preferred.

**I understand that prior to anesthesia: (A) All animals should be up to date on vaccines for at least 10 days. (B) All animals, except avian and some exotics, should be fasted overnight (food and water). (C) Dogs should be on heartworm prevention and tested yearly or tested prior to surgery for heartworms. (D) Bloodwork should be done before any anesthetic procedure. (E) Omission of any of these measures may increase the normal risk and anesthetic complications, such as death, that is present with any anesthetic procedure.**
