



# Flea killing checklist

## Are all of your animals currently being treated for fleas?

\* We highly recommend that you treat all of your animals even if they do not ever go outside. You can actually carry fleas in on your clothes or shoes.

## If so, what are you using?

\* We offer two of the latest products on the market.

**Frontline** has been on the market for many years and still works very well. We offer the Frontline topical and Frontline spray.

**Comfortis** is one of the newest flea preventatives. It is a once a month pill that is given orally so it works from the inside out.

\* Each of these preventatives **must** be used monthly for best results.

## Have you treated the areas that your animals occupy?

\* We use and recommend Spectracide® Triazicide® Insect Killer Once & Done. Spray your yard and home as directed on the bottle. We recommend that you spray every two weeks (due to the flea life cycle) until fleas are under control. It is also beneficial to vacuum all carpet and upholstery prior to treating the areas. **DO NOT allow animals on the treated areas until pesticide is completely dry.** For more information on how to keep your home and pets pest free please ask the staff at Bar N Veterinary Clinic.
