Preventative Health Requirements

- Cats MUST be current on FVRCP/HCP and Rabies vaccinations
 - The Leukemia vaccine is required for any cat that is not strictly indoors.
- Dogs MUST be current on DHPP, Bordetella, Leptospirosis, CIV and Rabies vaccinations.
- Each pet must have a 'No Parasites Seen' fecal within 6 months of their stay.

Proof of current vaccinations following Sylvania Veterinary Hospital's requirements is required at admission. Failure to provide these may result in your pet being given any missing vaccines during their stay at the owner's expense. We reserve the right to decline boarding services if the requirements are not met by the admission date.

***While vaccinations are a great way to protect your pet against preventable disease, nothing provides 100% immunity. At SylvaniaVET, we strive to prevent cross contamination through strict cleaning and isolation protocols. However, anytime your pet enters our facility there is a small chance they may come into contact with disease causing pathogens and become infected in some capacity as a result. By signing this agreement, you understand the risks associated with boarding your pet. ***

Medical Care While Boarding

- Fleas, ear mites, and any other contagious disease will be treated at the owner's expense.
- Emergency medical care will be provided at the owner's expense when necessary. Every effort will be made to contact the owner if an emergency arises, however, all necessary care will be provided by our professional staff if an owner or emergency contact is unable to be reached. The boarded pet(s) will be moved to the hospital at normal hospitalization rates.
- If a pet soils itself, a bath will be given at the owner's expense. We will not allow a pet to go home unclean.
- If your pet is not eating well during their stay, we will do everything we can to encourage them to eat. We supply dry food free of charge.
- If you supply your pet's own food and it runs out, we will follow our standard feeding protocol.
- Any canned food necessary will be at the owner's expense.
