

Sylvania Veterinary Hospital Doggie Daycare offers an enjoyable, recreational, and educational experience for your dog. Want to go run an errand or don't want to leave your dog at home while you're working? Bring them to daycare and enjoy the benefits of a happy, relaxed dog!

### **Services Included:**

- Constant supervision, 2-3 staff members are with the dogs at all times.
- Indoor, climate controlled playroom with specialized rubber flooring
- Large fenced outdoor space with shaded areas along with play equipment and pools in the summertime
- Outdoor time provided every 10-15 minutes
- Vet approved toys for playtime
- Supervised playtime with staff and with other dogs
- Treat times (depending on dogs and their dietary restrictions)
- Feeding times when food is provided by owner
- Constant access to fresh water, soft beds and blankets, and crates for nap time

### **Additional Services**

- Boarding
  - Daycare playtime is available to dogs that are currently boarding with us. After completing a daycare interview, your dog can spend additional time playing outside of boarding. Amount of time is based on your dogs comfortability and owners requests.
- Never Home Alone (NHA)
  - Daycare time is also available for dogs that are using our Never Home Alone program. This way your dog can spend a few hours in daycare while also enjoying some relaxation time in boarding.
- Grooming
  - Approved dogs can visit daycare before and after their grooming appointments upon owners request.
  - If scheduled with grooming or with a Veterinary Technician, your dogs nails can be trimmed while in daycare.

### **Hours of Operation**

Monday-Friday 7:00 am - 6:00 pm

Saturday 8:00 am - 2:00 pm

Sunday Closed

Early drop off is available upon request.

Late pick up is available through our Never Home Alone program.

### **Required for Daycare**

#### Interviews:

- All dogs are required to complete an acceptance interview and have updated vaccines before attending daycare. Applications can be filled out in advance, but an appointment must be set up with daycare for the interview.
- Interviews are free of charge and are about an hour long.
- Dogs that visit other veterinary hospitals must have their records sent to us in advance before they can attend an interview.

#### Preventative Health

- All dogs must be current on:
  - DHLPP- Distemper Hepatitis, Leptospirosis-four Strain, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus
  - Bordetella
  - Rabies
  - CIV- both H3N2 and H3N8 strains
  - A negative fecal within the last six months
  - Monthly flea, tick, and heartworm medication
- All dogs after 6 months of age must be spayed or neutered to attend daycare

#### Medical Care while in Daycare

- All dogs that enter daycare will be checked for fleas, papilloma, and for any signs of coughing or sneezing.
- We do not recommend dogs that are currently sick attend daycare. Dogs that are currently being treated for worms or parasites will not be allowed to enter daycare.
- We do not recommend that your dog attends daycare after either receiving multiple vaccines or a vaccine they have not received before. We recommend waiting 24 hours before returning to daycare.
- Emergency care will be provided at owner's expense
- Every effort will be made to contact the owner if an emergency arises, however all necessary care will be provided by our professional staff.
